We are so excited and pleased to be contacting you about Mountain Top Kids Camp July **10-14, 2023**. We would like to invite you (kids who have completed 3rd through 6th grade) to a week's worth of God's interactive wonders on Casper Mountain. MTBA

Kids Camp offers a week filled with diverse kid-centered activities including:

- Solid, Bible-based lessons
- Active, hands-on learning stations such as Weird Science, Survivor, Archery, Stomp, Recreation, Crafts, Messengers, and Bible Adventure
- Live worship specifically designed to engage kids in a celebration of the King of Kings
- A caring team of leadership staff dedicated to introducing children to the Savior and helping them strengthen their faith
- An affordable cost of \$115 which includes a t-shirt & water bottle
- A camp wide surprise on Thursday, that includes every person on the mountain and will have your child talking about his/her experience for years to come

The Southern Baptist Mountaintop Campus features comfortable cabin accommodations, a renovated bath house, Robbin's Chapel worship center, an on-site nurse, as well as many other wonders nestled in the mountain. Our cost includes 3 meals per day as well as 1 snack per day. Children will have opportunities to purchase items from the snack shack/concession at an extra cost (optional).

One of the best things about MTBA Kids camp is that all of our staff and sponsors are volunteers! Our staff provides the activities, live worship, and energy so that the church sponsors from **your home church** can facilitate and foster intentional relationships that will go back home to your church. We ask that each church provides 1 adult sponsor (age 18 or older) per 5 student campers, for each gender. We do understand that this can be a difficult task and encourage you to make other arrangements with sister churches. In some cases, we can also help accommodate your sponsor needs if enough notice has been given to make arrangements. However, if at all possible, we encourage you to bring your own sponsors so that you can follow-up with your campers after the week has concluded. We love seeing familiar faces as well as new ones and hope you will thoughtfully consider MTBA Kids Camp.

It is a great pleasure to spend this time with each and every camper and sponsor. Our enthusiastic Dream Team is invested in your child as well as kingdom growth. We are not the oldest camp, we are not the largest camp, but we are a **Christ-centered & kid focused camp**! We are small enough to create a caring and safe environment but big enough for campers to build relationships with other kids from around Wyoming. Our philosophy is simple. You are entrusting us with your most valuable possession. It is our job to responsibly care for your child while providing fun activities that will challenge them mentally, physically, and creatively all with the goal to immerse them in the love and growing knowledge of Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

This ensures that each student will have accommodations. *After the above-mentioned date: shirt size cannot be guaranteed.

7. A Medication registration form that ensures your child is appropriately cared for.

What to Bring to Camp

- ★ Warm Sleeping Bag
- ★ Fitted Twin Sheet (optional)
- ★ Pillow
- ★ Towel & Washcloth
- ★ Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- ★ Hairbrush, Shampoo, Soap, Ect.
- ★ Bug Spray & Sunscreen
- ★ Flashlight
- ★ Bible
- ★ Notebook & Pen (optional)
- ★ Jacket or Raincoat
- ★ Modest Clothing (No short shorts, spaghetti straps, tank tops, see-through shirts, halter tops, ect.)
- ★ Closed-Toe & Closed Heel Shoes - Tennis Shoes/Hiking Boots (We cannot allow any part of foot to be exposed)
- ★ Shower Shoes - Flip Flops (to be used **only** in showers)
- ★ Necessary Medications (to be given to on-site nurse upon arrival at camp)
